CYPRUS CIRCUIT SERIES

The Cyprus Badminton Federation (CBF) announces the [Cyprus U13 Circuit 2026](#) **Championship**.

The Championship is part of the Cyprus Circuit series, serves as a ranked tournament, and will be conducted in accordance with the individual championship regulations of the CBF.

Separate competitions will be held for all events (Singles, Doubles, and Mixed Doubles). Events with fewer than four (4) entries will not be conducted and will not count toward national rankings.

1. Venue and Dates

The Championship will take place on **October 10 & 11, 2026**, at the “**Evangelos Florakis**” **Sports Hall**, Nicosia.

2. Eligibility

All Cypriot, EU, or international athletes born **on or after January 1, 2014**, are eligible to participate.

- **CBF Athletes:** Must hold an active **CBF ID** and a valid **KOA Health Card**.
- **Non-CBF Athletes:** Must be registered through their respective **BWF Member Associations**.

3. Entry Submission

Entries must be submitted in writing to the CBF Technical Committee via email at **badminton@cytanet.com.cy** no later than **Monday, October 5, 2026, at 13:00**.

For non-CBF athletes, entries must be officially endorsed and submitted by their respective BWF Member Association.

4. Draw

The draw will take place at the Federation’s offices on **Wednesday, October 7, 2026, at 11:00**, in accordance with CBF regulations. The *Badminton Tournament Planner* software will be used for conducting the draw.

5. Entry Fee

The entry fee is set at **€15 per player**.

6. Awards & Trophies

Champions, runners-up, and third-place finishers in each category will be awarded trophies/medals.

7. Official Shuttlecock

VICTOR CHAMPION No. 3 shuttlecocks will be used exclusively.

8. Referees

The Referee for the tournament will be announced prior to the event.

9. Scoring Format

Matches will be played as best of 3 sets to 15 points (up to a maximum of 21 points).

10. Insurance & Liability

The CBF assumes no responsibility for medical costs or claims arising from injuries or property damage. Participants are required to arrange their own insurance coverage.

11. Media & Image Rights

By submitting an entry form and participating in the Championship, all involved parties (athletes, coaches, and companions) consent to being photographed and/or filmed during matches and official activities. The CBF reserves the right to use such material for promotional, media, and archival purposes without time limitation or financial compensation.

12. General Provisions

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend or revise this notice as deemed necessary.
